The Institute was renamed in 2005 after the passing of our leader and great visionary Richard E. Smalley.

The Institute's vision is to **solve humanity's most pressing problems through the application of nanotechnology**. The institute is comprised of over 140 faculty members in over 13 departments and hundreds of students and post-doctoral fellows. Rice University is arguably the largest concentration of nanotechnology researchers in the world.
